






REASONS WHY RESPONDENTS ENTER UKRAINE

LEGAL STATUS OF RESPONDENTS AT THE TIME OF SURVEY

more than

- With no grounds for the stay in Ukraine
- 38.6% With irregular status experience

Including 40% of Syrians, about half of Afghans, more than 70% of Somalis who had such experience.

 The periods of residence in Ukraine irregularly were from a few weeks to six years.

A third of respondents with relevant experienced irregular residence for over one year.


COMPOSITION OF IRREGULAR MIGRANTS



The most numerous are former students or those who were expelled due to the failure to pay. They make the half, probably. The second group are those who were transferred to Ukraine, mainly from Russia, they make a third, probably. The third group are those who stayed after their visas had expired but could not find any other grounds to stay."

REASONS FOR HAVING IRREGULAR LEGAL STATUS

- Imperfect, long and non-transparent procedure for obtaining documents
- Unawareness of migrants of the requirements to obtaining documents
- Cases of corruption, deception by smugglers and unofficial intermediaries
- Failure to submit documents due to lack of hope for receiving the status
- Problems of irregular status arising from registration of marriage
- Problems that irregular migrants lacking documents will face in the future after their stay in TAC

ESTIMATION OF THE NUMBER OF IRREGULAR MIGRANTS

According to the experts,

up to 25% of immigrants may stay in the country without permits


- 86.9% of civil servants who are experts
- 94.2% of community leaders,
- 84.7% of NGO representatives shared this opinion.

32.5% of surveyed migrants believed that

up to 25% of the compatriots do not have documents for staying in Ukraine

At the same time, migrants from Eritrea, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh said that the proportion of irregular migrants among their compatriots was 70–90%.
