IOM released its Strategic Response Plan for Ukraine and Neighbouring Countries for 2024-2026 to mitigate the adverse effects of the war and foster economic recovery. Overall financial ask to implement the three-year plan is USD 1.5 billion. The strategy contextualizes the IOM Global Strategic Plan to the specific dynamics of Ukraine and the broader region, indicating our priorities and funding needs to deliver on the three objectives: (1)

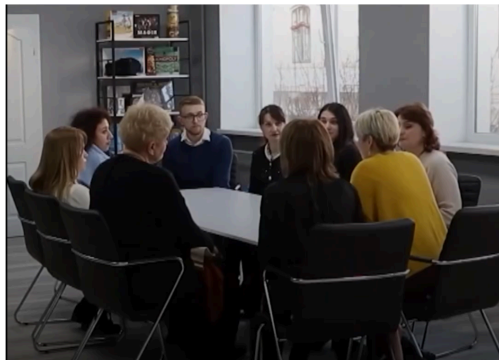

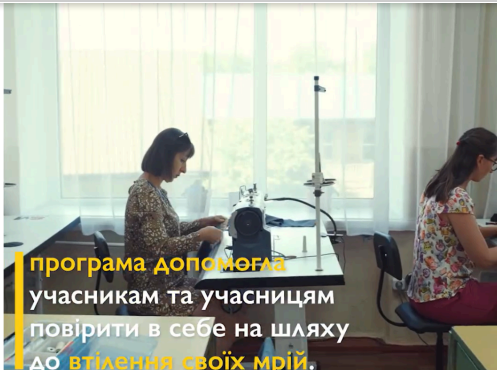

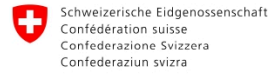
